## Patch Test Consent Form



### Patch Test Explanation:

A patch test is a precautionary measure taken to check for any potential allergic reactions to the adhesive glue used in eyelash extensions. During the patch test, a few lashes will be applied in different places. We will monitor the area for any adverse reactions over the next 24-48 hours.

### Allergic Reactions and Risks:

While rare, allergic reactions to eyelash extension adhesive can occur. Symptoms may include redness, itching, swelling, or irritation in the area where the adhesive was applied. In severe cases, reactions may involve puffiness of the eyes or rash on the face. If you experience any of these symptoms, it is essential to notify us immediately and seek medical attention if necessary.

### Patch Test Procedure:

1. The patch test will be performed at least 24-48 hours before your scheduled eyelash extension appointment.
2. A small amount of lashes will be applied to different places.
3. The area will be monitored for any signs of irritation or allergic reaction over the next 24-48 hours.
4. If you experience any adverse reactions during this time, please contact us immediately.
